[Direction of policy]

This mailing list exists for occultation researchers and observers in the whole East Asia region. In addition, this mailing list also takes over the purpose of Phaethon mailing list.

Accordingly, this mailing list has the following directions which are oriented by above each.

- (1) Observations which require inter-regional cooperation.
- (2) Observations oriented to research.
- (3) Campaign observations for the target bodies of the spacecraft exploration programs.
- (4) Interesting occultation phenomena (ex. occultation of Planet, TNO, Comet, mutual event of satellite etc.)

Above each (1)-(4) includes prediction, location and observation, analysis, reducing, articles etc.)

- (5) Techniques of observation and analysis which are necessary to be discussed by members of the whole East Asia.
- (6) Newest information of occultation science
- (7) Information about management of IOTA/EA (Workshop, Strategy meeting for group observation, communication memo etc.)
- (8) Collaboration with other regions of IOTA.
- (9) Issues related to whole IOTA/EA.

Discussion and information other than those exemplified above are welcome, as long as it is aimed at fulfilling the objectives of IOTA/EA.
