Rules of raw data archiving of "out-of-campaign" events

- 1. Purpose
- -- To archive a raw data set of non-campaign events which might be used for publication but otherwise would not be archived in the collection process of ordinary observational events
- 2. Criterion for decision
- -- Events potential for refereed publication (requests of re-analysis might be assumed in the future)
- --e.g. events strongly-requested by parties such as the IOTA (including individuals)
- --e.g. events with scientific signification but were not on time of the selection process as campaign events
- 3. Procedure
- -- Representatives or directors of the IOTA/EA receive requests
- -- Discussion in the IOTA/EA Board of Directors in a timely manner
- -- The person in charge of archiving prepares a site for upload when approved
- -- The person in charge of archiving tells the proposer(s) (PI) how to upload the data

## 4. Contents

- -- Same as the campaign observations, namely :
  - -- raw movie or still images
  - -- camera setting information
  - -- time information by which absolute time can be derived
  - -- other data can be added if necessary
- 5. File name convention
- -- Same rule as the campaign observations is applied.
